CHARACTER Stories

Age Range: from 2 to 7 years old

Aim: To introduce the characters and the solidarity campaign, creating an interactive space with the students through storytelling

Development:

The teacher brings in a very special story called "The Crew Stay at Home" which is related to the Restart to Transform campaign. The campaign's characters will appear, narrating the experiences they've had in their countries and cultures and how the coronavirus has affected their lives.

These stories will be read in stages, each protagonist taking center stage for the day or the week. The stories will be related to the values that each character represents:

- Marine: Combating social exclusion
- Quisap: Environment and sustainable development
- Sukal: Solidarity, and interculturalism
- Bla: Peace
- Calasang: Education
- Jiwa: Local-global relationships
- Elykia and Esengo: Coeducation
- Look: Health



During the story and at the end, there will be an interactive space between the character and the students to help solve the character's problem, turning it into an action that can be taken on by the class.
