Presentation of the social reality

- Itaka-Escolapios has a long experience of collaboration and work with migrant population since its beginnings through different initiatives and projects such as homes for young people, educational support in schools, literacy classes, integration actions through leisure time or awareness campaigns. Contact with these people has increased awareness of the difficult reality experienced by this group in general.
- The factors that produce the migration of thousands of people are diverse: demographic pressure, deteriorating living conditions, social or political instability and persecution, ecological problems, cultural and historical factors, the influence of the media, gender inequalities,... All these situations produce great suffering in people who are looking for a better alternative life for themselves and/or their families.
- This sensitivity is the fruit of our charm and is at the heart of our mission. Through our charm we place education at the service of those with whom the Lord wished to identify himself: "I was a stranger and you welcomed me" (Mt 25:35).
- The general objective of these projects is to facilitate the social, formative and labour insertion of the migrants who participate in the entity, accompanying them in an integral way in all the areas of their lives, until they demand or require it.

Simple description of the task to be carried out

There are several programmes or services within the project. All of them are designed to cover the existing, confirmed and demanded demand.

- Literacy classes and Spanish as a Foreign Language classes (El Faro, Ikaskide, Ojalá).
- Nursery and School Reinforcement Service (Ojalá-Txiki).
- Residential Resources/Homes
- Different housing models, with different educational presence in each

one of them.

- Socio-Labour Guidance
- Some presences have accredited offices.
- Qualifying or pre-qualifying training, aimed at labour insertion
- Complementary training
- Services to cover the basic needs detected (Showers / Lockers - Clothes Delivery...).
- Leisure and free time activities



Achievements in the last years

- Recognition to accredit some of the training courses we provide (Certificates of Professionalism, Complementary Training to CP, Specialities...).
- Recognition as Socio-labour Guidance Offices.
- Growth in homes and residential resources
- Recognition of all the people (volunteers, students, workers...) as Itaka participants. Concept of the "new we are".



Future intentions (lines of improvement)

- To be able to recognise ourselves in some presence as a School for Adults (EPA).
- To incorporate in the Insertion Companies Project that facilitate the Regularisation and the access to the labour market.
- To continue researching on Qualifying Training in which it is possible to be accredited.
