Presentation of the social reality

All the participants are from disadvantaged areas, of low resources with security problems, roads, scarcities of water and light. The families, mostly dysfunctional with incomplete family nucleus, in the neighbourhood there are no schools that can respond to their needs and educational difficulties, having as a result no schooling of these children and young adults.



Simple description of the task to be done:

The activities that are provided to the beneficiaries, seek to respond to the needs of the participants, giving him tools that help him to develop at a personal and social level, with a trade that can develop and put in practice, said trades start from manual areas such as piñatas, decorations, bakery, kitchen. A part of the entrepreneurship training personal growth is provided, helping them to interact better with society, all this is going to be given in a gradual way depending on the skills and limiters of each participant.
